Random Play-1st Round

The tournament will begin with all teams engaging in 5 random games. Teams will be placed arbitrarily into divisions as they sign up. 32 teams total, 4 divisions of 8 teams each. The four divisions will be identified by the following colors: Red, White, Blue and Green. Random play games will be 7 innings. One side throws for the top of the inning; the other side throws back for the bottom of the inning. Keep track of innings and score. If there is a tie after the 7th inning, extra innings are played until the tie is broken. Team only has to win by one point. The bottom of the inning has to be played, no sudden death.

The winning team is responsible for reporting the win and score to the scorer's table. Games should take approximately 15 minutes each.

After the first round, there will be an intermission for tournament director to seat the teams in the Single Elimination brackets for the 2nd round of play.

Single Elimination Tournament-2nd Round

The top 3 teams in each division will be in the Gold Tournament, the middle 3 teams in the Silver and the bottom 3 teams in the Bronze. Bracket seating will be based on win loss records and total points scored. Single Elimination Tournament games play to 21, only need to win by one point.

General Rules

- 3 Points for in the hole, 1 point for on the board
- During Round 1, cancellation scoring will be in effect- if opposing players throw a bag in the hole each for 3 points they cancel and no points are awarded
- Use the next open court after a match is completed. Do not use the same board again. Keep schedule moving - no long breaks
- Each player can take a couple warm up throws before each game
- Bags stay with the boards, no playing with the same bags all day!
- Gentlemen's agreement for sides and who throws first. Once sides are agreed upon, players must remain at the chosen sides for the entire game
- Schedule is listed by Team Color and Name
