

## BEWSF Application 2018-2019

**BEWSF Mission:** Encourage high school students to serve as leaders in their community by exercising sound judgment and committing themselves to volunteer programs that make a positive impact in their lives and the lives of others.

In order to apply for the BEW Scholarship, please review the qualifying criteria before you proceed. If you do not fulfill all the underlined points your application will not be considered further.

# **Qualifying Criteria**

- Must have graduated 8th grade from a school in Elmhurst, IL. or be currently enrolled at a high school in Elmhurst, IL.
- Participated in a minimum of 3 extracurricular activities throughout time spent in high school
- Submit a copy of your official high school transcript
- Submit 2 letters of recommendation from a: teacher, coach, boss, community leader, etc. that you have interacted with in the last five years
- During years at high school, fulfilled 25 hours of volunteer outreach service toward a cause you are committed to
- If selected as a finalist, submit proof of acceptance to a college, trade school or institution of higher learning and enrollment for the fall semester of 2019-2020

The BEWSF and members of the selection committee reserve the right to request a phone and or in person interview for the final candidates in the selection process in order to determine who is most deserving of the award.

The BEWSF will award a one time scholarship to one high school senior to support the costs of tuition in his/her first semester during the Fall of 2019. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the educational institution the recipient will be attending. The award is non-refundable and cannot be exchanged for cash value under any circumstances to the recipient. If the full amount is not completely used during the first semester the remaining balance will be used to support tuition costs for the Winter and Spring semesters of 2020 If the selected recipient does not enroll for classes during Fall 2019, the award will be granted to a back up recipient who will attend classes during Fall 2019.

It is the sole discretion of the BEWSF to change the qualifying criteria on an annual basis. The scholarship award amount may also vary from year to year depending on several factors, including but not limited to operational costs and the amount of donation money raised.



#### **Application Instructions**

We look forward to reviewing your responses in consideration of the 2018-2019 scholarship award. We are honored you have chosen to become part of the tradition of remembering Brian E. Wagner. In the spirit of selecting a recipient we commend you for taking the initiative to be recognized. Although we can only award one scholarship we want to acknowledge all of you for emerging as young leaders. I also acknowledge the BEWSF and any members of the selection committee have the right to request a phone and/ or in person interview if I am selected as one of the finalists for the scholarship. Declining an interview may result in disqualification and prevent me from being chosen as the scholarship recipient.

I understand by submitting this application I am not guaranteed to receive college funding but rather I am being considered for a scholarship award among other applicants. If selected for the award, I agree to submit proof of my acceptance and enrollment to the educational institution I plan to attend in the Fall Semester of 2018. Failing to provide this documentation when requested by the BEWSF selection committee may result in a forfeiture of the award.

If selected as the scholarship recipient, I agree to use the award money toward tuition costs only. I will allow the BEWSF to pay tuition costs on my behalf during the Fall semester of 2019. If there is a remaining balance after the Fall semester of 2019 I will permit the BEWSF to use the remaining funds for tuition costs during the Winter and/or Spring semesters of 2020. Not accepting these terms may prevent me from using the scholarship funding towards my educational tuition. I comply with the all the terms and conditions stated in this application and with prospective terms and conditions that may be disclosed by the BEWSF in the future.
